

Survey Your School

Time needed: 30 minutes

Recommended Level: Grade 5-8

Categories: Awareness, Bystanders, Helping victims

Common Core Standard(s): Ratios & proportional relationships, Statistics & probability

Purpose: Students will determine the frequency of bullying in their school and will determine what actions they might be doing to contribute to bullying.

DISCUSSION:

Discuss with students the common characteristics of a bully. Discuss with students whether these characteristics are only found in bullies.

Discuss with students what interactions people have every day that may lead to bullying situations.

ACTIVITY:

Each person in the class should survey a classmate and ask the following questions:

- Have you ever been bullied? Yes or No
- How have you been bullied: Verbal, physical, cyber?
- Name the three most common places bullying occurs at your school.
- Have you ever bullied someone? Yes or No

FOLLOW-UP:

Expand the activity outside your class and have students interview multiple students.

Tally the answers to the questions and graph the results.
